**Rules & Regulations:** Please read carefully

1. Show management reserves the right to divide, combine, and/or cancel any class at its discretion.
2. No lame horses allowed to show.
3. For insurance reasons all participants are required to sign a release form. In the case of a minor, the form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
4. Horses are shown at owner/exhibitor risk. Hemstreet Farm Inc. dba Riding Right Farm assumes no responsibility for damage to horses, riders, vehicles or any articles at the show.
5. Age Divisions: Ages as of January 1st of current year. Riders are not allowed to show in more than one division.
  - Beginner walk/trot: 12 and Under.
  - Open walk/trot 13 and over
  - Novice Junior: 13 and under-First year showing w/t/c
  - Juniors: 13 and under.
  - Seniors: 14-17
  - Adult: 18 and over.
6. All participants must wear proper attire for classes unless otherwise stated. Chaps are optional in all western classes. Approved protective headgear is accepted in any class and in accordance with NYS law is required by all riders under age 18. Show management requires the use of approved headgear in jumping classes.
7. Negative Coggins Test and Rabies papers are required. Must be dated within two years of current show date.
8. USEF rules will be used as guidelines for this show. However, some rules may be changed to suit the needs of this show.
9. No martingales, tie downs, mechanical hackamores, draw reins or other controlling devices allowed, except in the case of jumping classes where martingales will be permitted.
10. Any rider not having his/her horse under control may be asked to leave the ring.
11. If your horse is a kicker please braid a red ribbon in the tail.
12. Good sportsmanship is highly regarded by show management. Bad treatment of horses and fellow show participants and observers will not be tolerated.
13. Alcoholic beverages not allowed on show grounds.
14. Smoking on show grounds is prohibited.

**Snack Bar on Show Grounds: Open 8:00 am until the end of the show.**

**Directions:** Farm is at the intersection of Washington Co. Routes 59 & 59A.

Points South & East: To use the Buskirk Covered Bridge take Route 67 east from Schaghticoke to Buskirk. Left turn onto County Route 103 for 1/4 mile to Covered Bridge. After crossing bridge turn left. Farm is 1.5 miles on right. Option: Take Route 67 East from Schaghticoke Fair. Third left onto Route 114. Road becomes Route 74 at Washington County line. Turn right onto Route 59A at the Pleasant Valley Grange in S. Cambridge. Farm is 1 mile on left.

Points North & West: Take Washington County Route 74 to South Cambridge. Turn onto County Route 59A for 1 mile. When 59A runs into County Route 59, Farm is on left.
